



SKINS PLAYING CONDITIONS 2018

1. All pool matches are 60 minutes in duration with no time outs or substitutions in the last 5 minutes. There will be a maximum of 10 minutes change over between matches
2. Premiership points will be allocated on the basis of:
Win – 3, Draw 2, Loss – 1, Forfeit – 0
1 Bonus point applies for each set won
3. An unfinished set will not count towards the match result unless one of the teams has reached 15 points and holds a 2-point advantage.
4. All points in an unfinished set will count towards point %.
5. Any point that is in progress at the expiry of any timed matches **will** count towards the result (for avoidance of doubt, if the referees blows their whistle to serve before the time expires, the rally must be played and the result of that point will count)
6. Any qualification finals will be the BEST of **3 sets** only
7. All divisional finals to decide the winner will be BEST of **5 sets**
8. International rules will apply in all matches with the exception of:
 - a) The 12 Sub rule.
 - b) A Libero player may be changed each set
 - c) The “Skins” Rule (See “Skins” section below)
9. Teams rostered for duty will be required to supply at least 2 linesmen, one Main Referee, one net referee, and at least one scorer. The provision of a scoreboard operator is encouraged, but is optional.
- 10.** Penalties for lack of duty members at the start of, or during a match, will be the loss of 1 (one) premiership point per duty member absent. Teams penalised under this rule will be notified after the match has been completed. Late arrival of duty teams by more than 5 minutes will result in the loss of 3 premiership points.
11. Teams must present at least six players for the start of each match, but if through injury only during the match this number is reduced to five, the team will be permitted to continue to play without penalty. Teams playing with five players must play with a “space” in the empty position, maintaining other rotational positions. Should a team be reduced to less than five players, the match, or remainder of, will be forfeited, but any points gained during the unfinished match will be retained for the purpose of calculating percentages.
12. A player must be available to take the court in at least 60% of available matches to be eligible for finals or have sought an exemption from the Tournament Director
13. All members of the team must be uniformly attired, including shirts and shorts.
14. All players will play at their own risk and Volleyball Ballarat will not be held responsible for medical and associated costs incurred
15. The interpretation and decision of the Volleyball Ballarat Tournament Director will be final on all matters covered in these rules.
16. Any disputes or protests that arise during a match shall be referred to the Chief Referee, Volleyball Ballarat Venue Manager or Tournament Director for immediate resolution.

“SKINS” RULES

1. A “Skin” is won when a team **wins a set against their opponent 25 – 12 or better.**
2. The team must shout “Skin” and the Duty team must note the time of the ‘Skin’ in the comments section of the on the score sheet.
3. Where two or three matches from the same division are played at the same time on different courts, the first team to win a “Skin” in that time slot will be entitled to all “Skins” and/or any jackpot “Skins” available in that timeslot. The time entered on the score sheet will be considered the deciding factor if more than one team claim a “Skin” in that timeslot.
4. If no “Skin” is won during a scheduled pool match(es), the allocated money will jackpot to the next pool match(es) and/or timeslot in that division.
5. Each division has prize money allocated to it as listed below
6. Any remaining “Skins” monies that have not been won during the pool matches including any qualifying finals will go into the prize pool to be split 70/30 between the 2 finalists with the winner receiving 70% and Runner Up 30% (3-6 team divisions)
7. If third place prizemoney is available (7 team Divisions only) Skins jackpots will be split 50/30/20%
8. Skins and Prizes will be paid by cheque or by direct deposit to named bank account in the week following the tournament

MENS DIVISION 1: 3 teams

SKINS = \$30 per match

PRIZEMONEY 1st = \$250 + 70% of any “Skins” Jackpot

PRIZEMONEY 2nd = \$100 + 30% of any “Skins” Jackpot

MENS DIVISION 2: 6 teams

SKINS = \$40 per match

PRIZEMONEY 1st = \$250 + 70% of any “Skins” Jackpot

PRIZEMONEY 2nd = \$100 + 30% of any “Skins” Jackpot

MENS DIVISION 3: 3 teams

SKINS = \$30 per match

PRIZEMONEY 1st = \$250 + 70% of any “Skins” Jackpot

PRIZEMONEY 2nd = \$100 + 30% of any “Skins” Jackpot

WOMENS DIVISION 1: 6 teams

SKINS = \$40 per match

PRIZEMONEY 1st = \$250 + 70% of any “Skins” Jackpot

PRIZEMONEY 2nd = \$100 + 30% of any “Skins” Jackpot

WOMENS DIVISION 2: 7 teams

SKINS = \$30 per match

PRIZEMONEY 1st = \$250 + 50% of any “Skins” Jackpot

PRIZEMONEY 2nd = \$100 + 30% of any “Skins” Jackpot

PRIZEMONEY 3rd = \$50 + 20% of any “Skins” Jackpot
